RESERVE LAW ENFORCEMENT CERTIFICATION FORM

- This form must be submitted with application for consideration to be given.
- The form must be signed by the Chief or Sheriff of the agency from which applicant is claiming Reserve Law Enforcement experience.
- The form must be notarized once completed.
- In order for Reserve Law Enforcement experience to be considered, the following standards must have been required by the agency:
 1. Applicant must have met all POST standards for a Reserve Law Enforcement Officer in the certifying state for each year of experience claimed, to include POST in-service requirements.
 2. Applicant must have worked, or been required to work, a minimum of 192 hours per year.
 3. Applicant must have completed a minimum of 80 hours of initial classroom training and a subsequent FTO program.
 4. Applicant must have possessed full law enforcement authority and powers of arrest.

If the above standards cannot be met, do not complete this form. Reserve Law Enforcement credit cannot be claimed on the application. If all of the above standards can be met, complete the lower section.
