- ❖ No solicitation shall begin prior to 9:00 a.m., and solicitation shall cease by 5:00 p.m. (CST) or 6:00 p.m. (CDST). Please follow the link below to view the ordinance.

- ❖ A Do Not Solicit Registry has been established for the City of Hendersonville. It is your responsibility to check this registry before knocking on any doors. The registry is live updating so multiple viewings per day of the registry is recommended. No person shall enter onto the property of any residence listed in the Do Not Solicit Registry for the purpose of soliciting. Any person found in violation of this section shall be guilty of an offense punishable by a fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00.) Should a permit holder be found guilty of violating this section in a final judgment from city court, his or her permit shall be revoked for one (1) year.
