

Hendersonville Drug Take-Back Box

The Hendersonville Police Department has provided a box for citizens to dispose of old or unused prescription and over-the-counter medications. The take-back box is located in the Hendersonville Police Department at 3 Executive Park Drive. Citizens can drop off medications everyday between 8 a.m. until 9 p.m.

Accepted Items Include:

- Prescription medications
- All over-the-counter medications
- Pet medications
- Medicated ointment, lotions, or drops
- Liquid medications in leak-proof containers
- Inhalers
- Pills in any packaging, including glass, plastic container, baggie (Ziploc) or foil

Items NOT Accepted Include:

- Illegal drugs or narcotics
- Needles/sharps or syringes with needles
- Blood sugar equipment
- Thermometers
- IV bags
- Bloody or infectious waste
- Personal care products (shampoo, lotions, etc)

Helpful Tips:

- Keep medications in the original container if possible
- Cross out your name and address
- Do NOT cross out the name of the medication
