NOVEMBER PRIMARY/GENERAL Election Campaign Sign Regulations

Based on Early Voting beginning on October 14, 2026

All Zones

- Obtain permission from the property owner.
- Must be located out of the public right-of-way and **at least 12 feet back from the edge of the street pavement** (not measured from the curb or unpaved shoulder).
- 1 sign per candidate/issue per lot. Signs must be flat and rigid (no banners). A collage of smaller signs on one sign/backing is not allowed. Corner lots are allowed 1 sign per candidate/issue per street frontage.
- May be displayed for 60 days prior to early voting per 2022 TCA statute, to 5 days after the official election day.
- Candidates which win a primary and remain on the ballot for an additional election shall be allowed to re-erect their signs or leave the signs in place for an additional sixty-one (61) day period under the above stated terms.
- Must be located on private property (with the owner's consent)
- No permit is required

Residentially Zoned Areas

- Maximum 16 square feet in size; Maximum 4 feet in height

Commercially Zoned Areas

- Maximum 32 square feet in size; Maximum 6 feet in height

Signs displayed in violation of the sign ordinance will immediately be removed by City Staff.

Signs are only allowed for candidates on the ballot in the next immediate election. For the November 3rd, 2026 election, signs may be displayed August 15th, 2026 through November 8th, 2026.

The Sign Regulations are not waived for early voting or on Election Day. The above regulations in regard to location and number still apply. Signs held by supporters at polling places are NOT regulated.

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Vehicle signs are prohibited by the City of Hendersonville Sign Ordinance. Vehicle signs are defined as: signs contained in, attached to, suspended from, or painted or displayed on any vehicle regularly parked within 50 feet of any street more than half the business day when one of the results of locating the vehicle is to display, demonstrate, advertise, or attract the attention of the public.

The City of Hendersonville classifies and regulates elections signs as temporary signs in Section 13 of the Zoning Ordinance. Portions of these regulations are preempted by TN Public Chap. 294, approved on 5/4/2017 and subsequent TCA amendments in 2022.
