

## **ADA Transition Plan**

### **Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act**

The City of Hendersonville is striving to make all City programs, services and facilities accessible to all persons, especially those with disabilities. The Americans with Disabilities Act Transition Plan is the City's commitment to providing equal access to all its public programs, services, facilities and activities for citizens with disabilities. To develop this plan, the City is engaging the services of a Professional Engineering Consultant to assist the City in performing a self-evaluation of all current City services, programs and facilities for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act Title II requirements. The Plan is intended to:

- Evaluate services, policies, and practices;
- Identify modifications needed to services, policies, and practices;
- Identify physical obstacles that limit the accessibility of facilities for individuals with disabilities;
- Describe the methods to be used to make the facilities accessible;
- Provide a schedule for making modifications to improve access;
- Identify the public officials responsible for implementation of the Transition Plan; and
- Involve people with disabilities in the preparation of the Plan.
