

# Personal History Statement

## INSTRUCTIONS

A critical part of a Police Officer's job is the ability to follow written and oral instructions.

**IF YOU HAVE BEEN CONVICTED, PLEADED GUILTY OR NO CONTEST TO ANY FELONY CHARGE OR ANY LAW RELATING TO FORCE, VIOLENCE, THEFT, DISHONESTY, GAMBLING, LIQUOR OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES, PURSUANT TO T.C.A. 38-8-106, YOU MUST BE DISQUALIFIED ACCORDING TO TENNESSEE PEACE OFFICERS STANDARDS.**

There is a waiver procedure in which one (1) of these transgressions can be waived by the POST commission. Multiple infractions will most likely result your application for employment being disqualified.

Hendersonville Police Department has a tattoo policy that states your tattoos must be tasteful and must be covered by the daily uniform. If you have tattoos that are in areas that cannot be covered, the use of a cover up "sleeve" is approved, however this may preclude you from taking special positions within the department.

Traffic History: Make sure you get everything. (Accidents and/or citation information) This may require you to contact the local agency and complete varying tasks prior to receiving the documentation.

ANY and ALL arrests MUST be disclosed, including expungements.

Your application must be neat and legible with NO blank spaces. If the question is not applicable to you please enter N/A as a response.

FYI, most local banks have notaries on hand to notarize documents.
