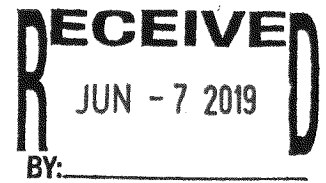
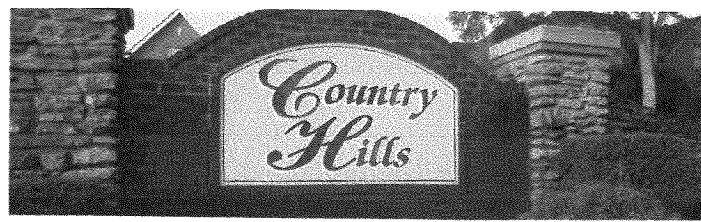

Dear Mayor Clary,

The Saundersville Exit (#8 on Vietnam Veterans, Hwy 386) is very rapidly becoming dangerous, if not a deadly interchange. When a CSX Freight Train is traveling North or Southbound, large numbers of vehicles (cars/trucks) are trapped in long lines waiting for several minutes until the tracks are clear causing traffic to back up on the exit and entrance ramps on Vietnam Veterans and coming onto Saundersville Road from Gallatin Road (31E). This potentially can have deadly consequences with the dramatic increases in traffic Sumner County is experiencing due to growth along 386, Gallatin Road and Saundersville Road.

Just today (June 4, 2019), at 9 AM there were vehicles backed up onto 386 (Vietnam Veterans), Saundersville Road past Avondale Road to the 386 entrance ramp as well as on Gallatin Road coming onto Saundersville Road. I would venture a guess that 50-60 vehicles possibly more were trapped with nowhere to go. Imagine if an emergency occurred during this gridlock and police, fire or EMS Vehicles were dispatched...precious minutes would be lost due to this unavoidable bottle neck.

This is not a Hendersonville problem alone. It is a State and Federal issue due to the population and traffic explosion Sumner County and the Statewide area is experiencing. Currently, it appears that the only areas in Middle Tennessee that are receiving State and Federal assistance is the Brentwood and Franklin area. Why??? Do we have to have a catastrophic issue with loss of life before this issue is addressed?

I am the President of the Country Hills Homeowner Association which is an Upper Socioeconomic subdivision and one of the most frequent questions I am asked is "when is something going to be done with this dangerous intersection?"

Mr. Mayor, the residences of not only Country Hills Subdivision, but Wyncrest, Stonecrest, Master's Glenn, Millstone, Wynbrooke and Saundersville Station plus Station Camp High School, Middle School and Elementary School in addition to all residences outside of these subdivisions which counts into the thousands are affected daily by the failure to address this dangerous intersection. Also, remember that a new subdivision with 626 new homes will soon be under construct adding more vehicles to the mix. We need immediate action from the State and Federal resources.
